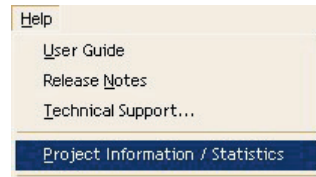


Project Information

How do I find out how many invitees or donors are in our project? How many items are there? What are the file names that contain our project data? Sometimes you want very basic information about your project data. **Auction!** provides a quick way to look up key summary information.

1. Click **Help, Project Information / Statistics**.
2. **Project Information** is displayed.



Project Name and Location

The upper section details project name, the location where data files are stored, and filenames associated with your project data.

The first line is the project name. The next line shows the exact path to the data files containing project data. The path begins with a drive letter, and shows each folder, or directory in the path structure. The path name may be very long. You can scroll to the right to see more detail.

Counting Names, Items, and Transactions

The lower section indicates numbers of records, by their various types. These counts can be useful for assessing the overall size of your dataset. When merging or working on a network, counts can be a quick check to determine you and your colleagues are working in the same copy of the dataset.

Tip

A single person can be an invitee, bidder, and donor at the same time. Therefore, the sum of bidder, donor, and invitee counts will generally NOT match the total for All Names.
